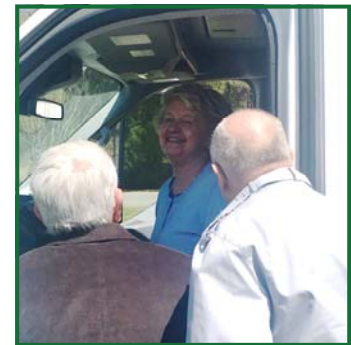

The commissioners met for a work session on April 5 in the new Board of Elections Training Center building.
