#### Courthouse Facilities Advisory Committee Update

A meeting of the Courthouse Facilities Advisory Committee was delayed by a week due to the inclement weather, but the group was able to convene on January 24 to provide feedback on a facility programming study completed by Solutions for Local Government and to review a revised project timeline. A request for qualifications for an architect has gone out and proposals are due back March 2, with a mandatory pre-bid meeting scheduled for February 2. The goal is to have a contract with an architectural firm prepared for the commissioners' consideration at one of their regular meetings in May, and to hopefully begin construction by May 2019. The Committee will meet again in March to discuss architect proposals received.
